### White Wines

Plaimont Cuvée du Roy IGP Cotes de Gascogne Sec - Southwest, France

Honest and unpretentious wine with a pleasantly harmonized crisp aroma and finish. Great as a party wine or as an aperitif to a wide range of dishes.

Amanti Del Vino Pinot Grigio - Delle Venezie, Italy

This Pinot Grigio is crisp, refreshing and unoaked. The bouquet is unmistakable and immediate, with an intense impression of acacia flowers. The palate is dry, full-bodied and well-balanced.

Ladera Verde - Chardonnay – Central Valley, Chile

Aquarius Marsanne Viognier, McPherson - Victoria, Australia

A fresh, vibrant and crisp wine with flavoursome notes of fresh honeysuckle and floral aromas. The Marsanne provides structure whilst the Viognier lends a fragrant carefully blanched punch. This wine is a joy to drink and a heavenly match with modern Asian food. Enjoy in peace, love and happiness.

Rioja Vega Tempranillo Blanco – Rioja, Spain

This Rioja Blanco has complex and expressive aromas, intense notes of tropical fruits and white flowers over delicate hints of herbs. Unctuous and sweet silky texture from the ageing on its fine lees in French oak barrels. A complex wine will keep well for many years to come.

Chablis, Domaine des Manants, Jean-Marc Brocard - Burgundy, France

A good balance between fruit and acidity, with good length and very elegant, a fine example of well-made Chablis. An excellent flinty, mineral fruit style typical of the Chardonnay grape from Chablis.

## Red Wines

### Amanti del Vino Sangiovese - Umbria, Italy

This has juicy, soft fruit with hints of black cherries and plums. Attractive, easy-going wine from Emilia-Romagna.

### Pato Torrente Merlot – Central Valley, Chile

This has juicy, soft fruit with hints of black cherries and plums. Attractive, easy going wine from Emilia-Romagna.

### Wide River Shiraz – Robertson, South Africa

Easy going, soft red with plenty of spicy, peppery fruit, this has good hedgerow berry flavours and power. Shiraz is proving to be a very popular and successful grape variety in the Cape.

### Gouguenheim Malbec – Mendoza, Argentina

Deep purple colour; pronounced blackberries and ripe plums with underlying spice on the nose. Soft with a slight sweetness and balanced by gentle tannins with a long spicy fruity finish.

### Los Coches Pinot Noir — *Central Valley, Chile*

A light body disguises lovely cherry flavour in the mouth. American oak aging gives a subtle, underlying vanilla influence and depth of flavour.

### Côtes du Rhone AOC Vieilles Vignes – Rhone, France

This is a good, simple Côtes du Rhône: it has typical peppery flavours and light, fresh fruit together with fine tannins.

### Bagordi Rioja Joven Organic – Rioja, Spain

This classic young Rioja has a bouquet of berry fruits and black liquorice with balsamic and spicy flavours in the background. This provides a complex and elegant experience on the nose. The lingering presence of fruit, gentle acidity and rounded flavours combine to give a clean, elegant finish.

### Château Puy-Blanquet St Emilion Grand Cru – Bordeaux, France

An outstanding Grand Cru wine from the ever popular village of Saint-Émilion. A pronounced wine on the nose with hints of ripe cherry fruits. Structured and firm on the palate with excellent length and depth of flavour.

## Rose Wine

Soleil des Alpes, Alpes de Hautes Provence Rose

This pale rosé has red berry aromas with hints of summer flowers. It is juicy and intense to taste with an attractive balance between soft berry fruit flavours, a touch of melon and refreshing minerality.

Whispering Angel, Cote de Provance Rose

## Sherry

Manzanilla Barbadillo Solear Sherry 37.5cl - Jerez, Spain

Manzanilla is a lightly fortified wine, unique to the coastal town of Sanlucar de Barrameda in Southern Spain. Solear is bright, fresh, delicate and extraordinarily dry with a long, nutty, tangy finish.

Barbadillo Pedro Ximinez – Jerez, Spain

Better known by its abbreviation PX this is the richest and stickiest of the sherry styles. By sun drying the grapes, Barbadillo have ensure that sugars become very concentrated indeed- hence the sweetness.

## Dessert Wine

DV by Ch Doisy Vedrines Sauternes – Bordeaux, France

This fresh wine has aromas of pineapple, mango and citrus fruit. There is a very good balance, not too much sugar in the mouth and a good vivacity, which gives the wine a finesse and character that makes you want to come back.

### Amori Prosecco Spumante

A delightfully crisp and elegant prosecco with vibrant apple and pear notes and a delicate, floral and fruity finish.
